



ASIA EURO UNIVERSITY HOLDS AN EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOP ON “THE IMPORTANCE OF LEARNING LAW, PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION, POLITICAL SCIENCE AND INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Asia Euro University (AEU) is a private higher education institution, which has been running for only 8 years from 2002 – 2010. From year to year, Asia Euro University, generally considered a leading education institution among universities in Cambodia, has considerably improved.

With very strong basis and its own buildings, every year AEU always invites well-known dignitaries and professors, doctors to give presentations on new discoveries and share good experiences to the students at AEU. Furthermore, those studying year 4 at AEU will be sent to be trained or to study at state and public institutions for 3 to 4 months so that they can learn about work, production line, and their thesis writing.

On August 26, 2010, we held an Educational Workshop on the importance of learning Law, Public Administration, Political Science, and International Relations. The workshop was attended by 3 well-known speakers: (1) **H. E. Dr. Ros Chantrabot**, Academician, Advisor to the Royal Academy of Cambodia and the expert of political science and history. (2) **H. E. Prof. Bun Hun**, Under Secretary of State of the Ministry of Justice and the expert of law, (3) **Dr. Chhim Phal Vorun**, Chairman of the Science Council and the expert of the constitutional law and political science. The workshop addressed the important experiences required at the present time and presented an insight into the choice of the above skills at undergraduate and graduate level schools in order to satisfy the students' needs and labour markets, especially to meet with our nation demands.

H. E. Dr. Ros Chantrabot, Academician, the expert of political science and history, said that the study of Political Science and International Relations enables us to know and to be good at (1) state work in international relations; (2) diplomacy, (3) understanding of leadership and management of state institutions, organizations, and other institutions (4) tele-communication, (5) decision analysis and plans for political prospects for the future.

H. E. Prof. Bun Hun, law expert, said that study of Law is very important for Cambodian society at present, which needs more law experts to work at ministries, state institutions, private companies and donors, especially the integration of Cambodia into the region and in the world in 21st century.

H. E. Prof. Bun Hun said that, of some subjects those studying Law can choose the fields of layer, judge, prosecutor, clerk, notary public, and bailiff or law consultant. All the skills are important to the contribution, law and justice reform in Cambodia.

Dr. Chhim Phalvorun, expert of the constitutional law and political science, described some important subjects of law such as constitutional, criminal,

civil, commercial laws, etc. He also stressed the importance of the subject of Public Administration, which enables students to have real skills of human resources management guidance in leadership and development of the organizational and political decision in public and private sectors such as skills of budget and financial management in an organization as well.

All the skills are necessary for both public and private institutions. He also added that those studying the above skills and difficult to find jobs are usually unclear about those subjects. The most important thing is that the students need to have practical knowledge. In contrast, Law, Public Administration, Political Science and International Relations are potential in the labour markets in both public and private sectors.

During the workshop, H. E. Duong Leang, Rector of Asia Euro University, said to ensure the quality of education, the university has made an effort to improve the study programs to satisfy the labour markets and society, including the education of virtue and rehabilitation in line with the development policy as well as the higher education of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport.

Finally, H. E. Duong Leang encouraged the student participants at the workshop to study hard since they can be considered as the bamboo shoots growing up to be bamboo and then go away from debaucheries, being abolished by society and obstacles to the nation's development as a whole. In this sense, all the students of the next generation must try to build their own ability to contribute to improving our country like other wonderful counties in regionally and internationally globalised stages.
